Communities informed by a history of colonial and post-colonial struggles, where weapons of words that undermined were as affective as weapons that inflicted physical violence. As Christians we follow the Prince of Peace and are called to a Ministry of Reconciliation. What does this look like in practice and how do we get there together? This consultation seeks to ask these questions and discern together the way ahead.
