

Session 3 - Activities to enhance integral mission in a world of conflict

1. In the first round of dialogue each participant was asked to pause prayerfully and then suggest one activity for the Micah Network strategy to enhance integral mission in a world of conflict.
2. In the second round, each participant was again asked to pause in prayer and propose one activity for the Micah Network strategy, discuss the details of suggested activities and as a group decide on one to propose.
3. After the meeting suggested activities were clustered and on the Friday participants voted on which ones they thought should have the highest priority. The results of the voting are detailed in Section 4 of the World Cafe session.

Summary of the Feedback from Collaborative Dialogue on Thursday

Suggested activities for the next Micah Network strategy to enhance integral mission in a world of conflict.

- As the local church is at the centre of God's purposes, the Micah Network is to facilitate the local church to fulfill its mission by (a) promoting inter-linkages among churches and between churches and para-church organizations, and (b) training local church members in integral mission.
- Micah Network to set up a resource data base and become a clearing house and a platform for sharing those resources such as bible studies, theological reflections, best practices, strategies, human resources, conflict resolution guides and contacts for funding.
- Micah Network to broaden membership to include more denominations (mainline churches), people groups (e.g. Arabic, Chinese and Korean) and sectors (e.g. justice, gender, theological education).
- Micah Network to strengthen its advocacy, justice and mediation roles.
- Micah Network's focus on prayer to be strengthened.
- Micah Network to join the World Council of Churches and Roman Catholic Church initiated week of prayer.
- Micah Network to focus on local and the national level activities.

How these suggested activities were formulated

These seven suggested activities were drafted by the facilitation team on the basis of proposed activities agreed to by the 30+ tables of Session 3's World Café dialogues, with further refinement offered by participants.
