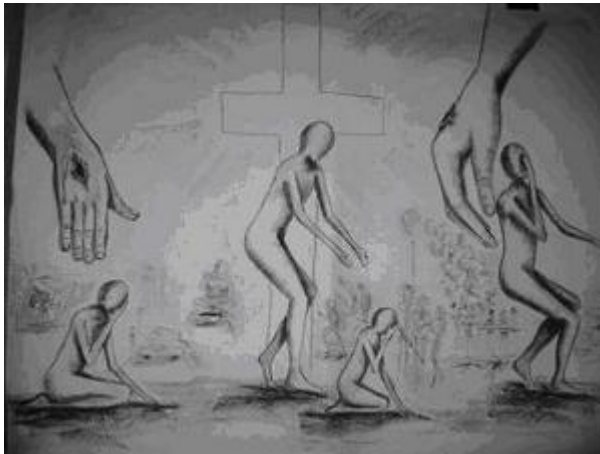


Session 4 - Ideas for moving forward



Results of polling

Participants voted on the outcomes from Session 3 and were able to use stickers to indicate their preferences / vote. The results were as follows:

- As the local church is at the centre of God's purposes, the Micah Network is to facilitate the local church to fulfil its mission by (a) promoting inter-linkages among churches and between churches and para church organizations, and (b) training local church members in integral mission - 27%
- Micah Network to set up a resource data base and become a clearing house and a platform for sharing those resources such as bible studies, theological reflections, best practices, strategies, human resources, conflict resolution guides and contacts for funding - 26%
- Micah Network's focus on prayer to be strengthened - 13%
- Micah Network to broaden membership to include more denominations (mainline churches), people groups (e.g. Arabic, Chinese and Korean) and sectors (e.g. justice, gender, theological education) – 12%
- Micah Network to strengthen its advocacy, justice and mediation roles - 11%
- Micah Network to focus on local and the national level activities - 6%
- Micah Network to join the World Council of Churches and Roman Catholic Church initiated week of prayer - 5%

These priorities were considered by each regional group and the feedback was then given to the Micah Network Executive who will use the feedback to prayerfully consider the way Micah Network can move forward and include these in the next strategy.
